

ORDINANCE NO. 98-04-01

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF WESTON, COLLIN COUNTY, TEXAS ELECTING EACH UNOPPOSED CANDIDATE TO THE OFFICE OF ALDERMAN OF THE CITY OF WESTON; CANCELING THE MAY 2, 1998 WESTON MUNICIPAL ELECTION; PROVIDING FOR THE POSTING OF THIS ORDINANCE ON ELECTION DAY AT THE POLLING PLACE, 117 MAIN STREET, WESTON, TEXAS; PROVIDING THE ISSUANCE OF A CERTIFICATE OF ELECTION TO EACH CANDIDATE IN THE SAME MANNER AS PROVIDED FOR A CANDIDATE ELECTED AT THE ELECTION.

WHEREAS, each candidate whose name was to appear on the official ballot for the May 2, 1998 Weston Municipal Election was unopposed after the 5 p.m. May 18, 1998 deadline to file application for a place on the ballot; and

WHEREAS, no write-in candidates filed declarations of write-in candidacy with the Weston City Secretary before the 5 p.m. May 18, 1997 deadline; and

WHEREAS, no proposition is to appear on the official ballot for the May 2, 1998 Weston Municipal Election ballot.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WESTON, COLLIN COUNTY, TEXAS:

Section 1. That each unopposed candidate be elected to the office of Alderman of the City of Weston, pursuant to Section 2.053 of the Texas Election Code.

Section 2. That the May 2, 1998 Weston Municipal Election be cancelled.


Section 3. That a copy of this Ordinance shall be posted on election day at the polling place, 117 Main Street, Weston, Texas.


Section 4. That a certificate of election shall be issued to each candidate in the same manner as provided for a candidate elected at the election.
