

RESOLUTION NO. 2003-02-03

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF WESTON, TEXAS, COLLIN COUNTY, TEXAS, SUPPORTING THE CURRENT EXEMPTION OF THE TEXAS STATE PLUMBING LAW, ALLOWING UNLICENSED PLUMBERS TO OPERATE IN COMMUNITIES UNDER 5,000 POPULATION

WHEREAS, the current Texas Plumbing Law is unclear as to whether an exemption to that law exists for communities of under 5,000 population; and,


WHEREAS, a bill will be introduced to the 78th Texas Legislature seeking to permanently remove said exemption; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Weston believes that there are experienced individuals within our community who are capable of completing quality plumbing work for our citizens with proper inspections by a qualified inspector.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Weston, Texas hereby requests that the 78th Legislature of the State of Texas approve a bill to be introduced by State Representative Sid Miller providing for the retention of an exemption allowing plumbing work in cities of less than 5,000 inhabitants to be performed by unlicensed plumbers.
