

RESOLUTION NO. 2006-02-03

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF WESTON, TEXAS, RATIFYING THE CITY'S APPLICATION FOR A WASTEWATER CERTIFICATE OF CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY AND WASTEWATER DISCHARGE PERMIT; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Weston, Texas is a Type A general-law municipality located in Collin County, created in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 6 of the Local Government Code and operating pursuant to the enabling legislation of the State of Texas; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has previously authorized the filing of an application for a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity to provide wastewater treatment service to areas within the City's territorial limit, extraterritorial limit and certain areas within the ultimate boundary of the City of Weston; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has previously authorized the filing of an application for a Domestic Wastewater Discharge Permit; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that there is a need for service in the area subject to the Applications (the "Area"), that written applications for service have been submitted to the City by property owners within the Area and that no other public or private entity provides such service to the Area; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that pursuant to the terms and conditions of that certain Development Agreement, dated December 13, 2005, the City of Weston has the capacity and ability to serve the area subject to the Applications; and

WHEREAS, based on the forgoing findings the City Council desires to ratify the City's applications with the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality for a Wastewater Certificate of Convenience and Necessity and a Domestic Wastewater Discharge Permit.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WESTON, TEXAS THAT:

SECTION 1.

The City Council hereby ratifies the City's applications with the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality for a Wastewater Certificate of Convenience and Necessity and a Domestic Wastewater Discharge Permit. The findings set forth above are hereby incorporated into this Section 1.

SECTION 2. EFFECTIVE DATE

This resolution shall be effective from and after its passage and adoption by the City Council.
