

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF WESTON AFFIRMING THAT THE CITY OF WESTON DOES NOT ABDICATE ANY RIGHTS OR AUTHORITY REGARDING THE PLANNING OR CONSTRUCTION OF ROADS OR THOROUGHFARES TO ANY THIRD PARTY.

WHEREAS, the City of Weston, Texas is a Type A general-law municipality located in Collin County, created in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 6 of the Local Government Code and operating pursuant to the enabling legislation of the State of Texas; and

WHEREAS, the City of Weston desires to maintain control over the planning and development of existing and future roads and thoroughfares within the cities corporate limits

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WESTON, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. The City of Weston does not abdicate any rights or authority regarding the planning or construction of its roads and thoroughfares to the any third party.

SECTION 2. EFFECTIVE DATE

This resolution shall be effective from and after its passage and adoption by the City Council.
