A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF WESTON, TEXAS, DIRECTING THE CITY ATTORNEY TO MOVE FOR A CONTINUANCE IN THE MATTER OF SOAH DOCKET NO. 582-06-2770/TCEQ DOCKET NO. 2006-0199-MWD, APPLICATION FOR WASTEWATER DISCHARGE PERMIT NO. WQ0014602001; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

- 1. To allow for time to study all pleadings and application materials filed to permit the City Council to familiarize itself with the nature of the pending application and to solicit and receive advice from the City's attorneys, engineers and the public regarding the same;
- 2. To negotiate in earnest with other all parties to the above-referenced matter in an effort to reach a mutually agreeable settlement and thereby avoid unnecessary expense and delay; and
- 3. So that justice may be done.

This resolution shall be effective from and after its passage and adoption by the City Council.
