4. EXECUTIVE SESSION –

As authorized by Section 551.071 and 551.074 of the Texas Government Code (Consultation with Town Attorney), this meeting may be convened into closed Executive Session for the purpose of seeking confidential legal advice from the Town Attorney on any agenda item herein. Additionally, pursuant to Texas Government Code, Annotated, Chapter 551, Subsection D, Texas Open Meetings Act (the “Act”), Council will recess into Executive Session (closed meeting) to discuss the following:

- Receive legal advice and discussion to deliberate the employment, evaluation, reassignment, duties, benefits, and discipline of the Town of Weston’s employees to include the Town Secretary and the Fire Chief;
- Receive legal advice regarding the EEOC complaint filed by Fire Chief;
- Receive legal advice regarding a Demand Letter and threatened litigation by a former Town employee; and
- Request legal advice regarding a third-party request for personnel records.

As authorized by Section 551.074 of the Texas Government Code, to discuss personnel matters:
