a. Consider and Act on reducing the speed limit on West Cottage Hill Parkway to 35 mph along the west side of Van Buren Estates, (CM Metzger)

Councilmember Whitworth made a motion to approve reducing speed limit to 30 mph on the south and west side of West Cottage Hill Parkway from Weston Road to Coolidge Road where the current signs are. Councilmember Metzger seconded the motion, and it carried 5-0.

b. Consider and Act on Approval of a Resolution of the Town of Weston, Texas, approving a development agreement pursuant to subchapter G, chapter 212 of the Texas Local Government Code between the Town of Weston and McCollum Estate Holding, LP; Governing the development of approximately 15.359 acres of land, to be named the Oaks of Weston, located jointly within the Town's territorial limits and extraterritorial jurisdiction; providing for the future annexation of the land; providing for a development plan; authorizing enforcement of land use and development regulations other than those that currently apply within the Town; providing for the design and construction of roadway and utility infrastructure; providing for additional non-substantive provisions; authorizing the Mayor to execute the agreement; and providing the effective date.
