AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING A BUDGET FOR THE ENSUING FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING OCTOBER 1, 2002, AND ENDING SEPTEMBER 30, 2003, FOR THE CITY OF WESTON, TEXAS IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE CONSTITUTION AND LAWS OF THE STATE OF TEXAS, APPROPRIATING THE VARIOUS AMOUNTS THEREOF, AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT THEREWITH; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the mayor of the City of Weston has submitted to the City Council a proposed budget of the revenues of said City and the expenses of conducting the affairs thereof and providing a complete financial plan for the 2002-2003 fiscal year and which said proposed budget has been compiled from information obtained from the Office of the City;

WHEREAS, the City Council has received said Mayor's proposed budget, a copy of which has been filed with the City Secretary of the City of Weston; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has conducted a public hearing on the budget, as provided by law.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WESTON, TEXAS THAT :

SECTION 1. The proposed budget of the City of Weston and the expenses of conducting the affairs thereof providing a complete financial plan for the ensuing fiscal year beginning October 1, 2002 and ending September 30, 2003, as submitted to the City Council by the Mayor of said City, and which budget is attached hereto as Exhibit "A", be and the same is in all things adopted and approved as the budget of all current revenue and expenses as well as fixed charges against said City for the 2002-2003 fiscal year.

SECTION 2. Ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall be and remain in full force and effect from and after its final passage and publication as herein provided.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall be effective on the date of its adoption.
