

ORDINANCE NO. 2017-09-03

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF WESTON, COLLIN COUNTY, TEXAS, RATIFYING THAT THE PROPERTY TAX RATE REFLECTED IN THE 2017-2018 FISCAL YEAR BUDGET WILL RAISE MORE TOTAL PROPERTY TAXES THAN IN THE 2016-2017 FISCAL YEAR'S BUDGET BY \$234, OR 0.36%, AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City Council has, prior to its consideration and adoption of this ordinance, adopted by separate ordinance the budget of the City of Weston for the 2017-2018 Fiscal Year; and

WHEREAS, the 2017-2018 Fiscal Year budget will raise more total property taxes than in the City of Weston's 2016-2017 Fiscal Year budget; and

WHEREAS, Section 102.007(c) Texas Local Government Code provides that upon the adoption of a budget that will raise more revenue from property taxes than in the previous year's budget that a separate vote of the governing body to ratify the property tax increase reflected in the budget, and that such a vote is in addition to and separate from the vote to adopt the budget or to set the tax rate; and

WHEREAS, the 2017-2018 Fiscal Year budget of the City of Weston, Texas will raise more revenue from property taxes than the 2016-2017 Fiscal Year budget by an amount of \$234 which is a 0.36 percent increase from the 2016-2017 Fiscal Year budget. The property tax revenue to be raised from new property added to the tax roll for the 2017-2018 Fiscal Year budget is \$1,456; and

WHEREAS, in order to comply with Section 102.007(c) of the Texas Local Government Code, it is necessary for the City Council of Weston, Texas to take the actions accomplished and evidenced by this ordinance.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WESTON, TEXAS THAT:

**SECTION 1
COMPLIANCE**

That in compliance with the requirements of in order to comply with Section 102.007(c) of the Texas Local Government Code, the City Council of Weston, Texas does hereby in all things ratify the property tax increase reflected in the 2017-2018 Fiscal Year Budget which will require raising more revenue from property taxes than in the 2016-2017 Fiscal Year budget.

**SECTION 3
EFFECTIVE DATE**

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication as provided by law, and it is so ordained.

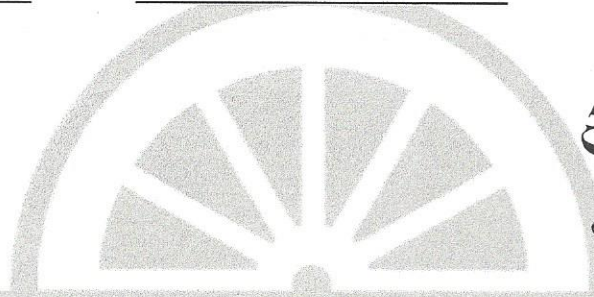
