

ORDINANCE NO. 2023-09-06

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF WESTON, COLLIN COUNTY, TEXAS, RATIFYING THE PROPERTY TAX INCREASE REFLECTED IN THE FISCAL YEAR 2024 BUDGET AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Section 102.007 of the Texas Local Government Code provides in part that the adoption of a budget that will require raising more revenue from property taxes than in the previous year requires a separate vote of the governing body to ratify the property tax increase reflected in the budget; and

WHEREAS, Section 102.007 of the Texas Local Government Code requires that this ratification be in addition to and separate from the vote to adopt the budget or a vote to set the tax rate required by Chapter 26, Tex. Tax Code, or other law; and

WHEREAS, the 2024 Fiscal Year Budget of the City of Weston, Texas will raise more revenue from property taxes than last year's budget by an amount of \$368,137, which is a 162.60 percent increase from last year's budget. The property tax revenue to be raised from new property added to the tax roll this year is \$228,057.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WESTON, TEXAS THAT:

SECTION 1 COMPLIANCE

In compliance with the requirements of Section 102.007(c) of the Texas Local Government Code, the City Council of Weston, Texas does hereby, in all things, ratify the property tax increase reflected in the 2024 Fiscal Year Budget which will require raising more revenue from property taxes than in the 2023 Fiscal Year budget.

SECTION 2 VOTE RECORD

A copy of the vote results sheet for this ordinance, reflecting the record vote of the City Council of Weston, Texas, shall be attached to this ordinance by the City Secretary and shall constitute a part of this ordinance for all purposes

SECTION 3 EFFECTIVE DATE

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication as provided by law, and it is so ordained.
