

ORDINANCE 2024-05-02

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF WESTON, COLLIN COUNTY, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING A BUDGET AMENDMENT FOR A MUNICIPAL PURPOSE AS AUTHORIZED BY TEXAS LOCAL GOVERNMENT CODE SECTION 102.010, IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE CONSTITUTION AND LAWS OF THE STATE OF TEXAS, REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT THEREWITH; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, City Council of the City of Weston, Texas ("City Council") previously adopted Ordinance 2023-09-01 setting forth the Budget for Fiscal Year 2024 beginning October 1, 2023, and ending September 30, 2024; and,

WHEREAS, Section 102.010 of the Texas Local Government Code authorizes the governing body of a municipality to make changes in the budget for municipal purposes; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that revenues and/or reserves are available for supplemental appropriation and/or transfer of certain funds to meet the requirement of this expenditure.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WESTON, TEXAS:

SECTION 1 ADOPTION

The budget for Fiscal Year 2024 of the City of Weston shall be amended to provide for necessary expenditures to the existing budget. The amendments to the Fiscal Year 2024 Budget of the City of Weston are summarized in Attachment A attached hereto and fully incorporated herein by reference, and are completely adopted and approved by the City of Weston City Council.

SECTION 2 CUMULATIVE REPEALER CLAUSE

This Ordinance shall be cumulative of all other Ordinances and shall not repeal any of the provisions of such Ordinances except for those instances where there are direct conflicts with the provisions of this Ordinance. Ordinances, or parts thereof, in force at the time this Ordinance shall take effect and that are inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent that they are inconsistent with this Ordinance. Provided however, that any complaint, action, claim or lawsuit which has been initiated or has arisen under or pursuant to such other Ordinances on the date of adoption of this Ordinance shall continue to be governed by the provisions of such Ordinance and for that purpose the Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect

SECTION 3 SEVERABILITY

Should any section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance be declared unconstitutional or invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, it is expressly provided that any and all remaining portions of this Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect. Weston hereby declares that it would have passed this Ordinance, and each section, subsection, sentence, clause, or phrase thereof irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, sentences, clauses, or phrases be declared unconstitutional or invalid.

SECTION 4 SAVINGS/REPEALING CLAUSE

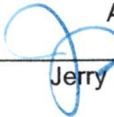
All provisions of any ordinance in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed; but such repeal shall not abate any pending prosecution for violation of the repealed Ordinance, nor shall the repeal prevent prosecution from being commenced for any violation if occurring prior to the repeal of the Ordinance. Any remaining portions of conflicting ordinances shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 5 EFFECTIVE DATE

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication as provided by law, and it is so ordained.

ORDINANCE NO. 2024-05-04

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF WESTON, TEXAS PROVIDING FOR THE APPOINTMENT OF THE CITY SECRETARY, AS AN OFFICER OF THE CITY; PROVIDING A CUMULATIVE CLAUSE; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Weston, Texas is a Type A general-law municipality located in Colin County, created in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 6 of the Local Government Code and operating pursuant to the enabling legislation of the State of Texas, and

WHEREAS, pursuant to 22.071 (b) of the Texas Local Government Code, the governing body of the Type A General Law municipality shall provide for the appointment of certain officers of the City by Ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has considered various applicants for the position of City Secretary for the City of Weston and now desires to effectuate the appointment of the successful candidate to such position, and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that such appointment is in the best interest of the public health, safety, and general welfare.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WESTON, TEXAS:

Section 1

That Kristina Dean is hereby appointed to the position of City Secretary of the City of Weston, Texas effective Jun 1, 2024.

Section 2

This ordinance shall be cumulative of all provisions of ordinances of the City of Weston, Texas as amended, except where the provisions of this ordinance are in direct conflict with the provisions of such ordinances, in which event the conflicting provisions of such ordinances are hereby repealed.

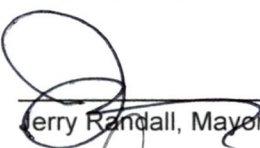
Section 3

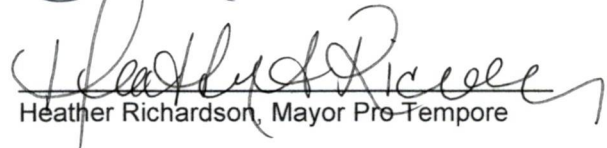
It is hereby declared to be the intention of the City Council that the phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs, and sections of this ordinance are severable, and if any phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph or section of this ordinance shall be declared unconstitutional by the valid judgment of decree of any court of competent jurisdiction, such unconstitutionality shall not affect any of the remaining phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs, and section of this ordinance, since the same would have been enacted by the City Council without the information in this ordinance of any such unconstitutional phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph, or section.

Section 4

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication as required by law, and it is so ordained.
