RESOLUTION NO. R-2026-01-02

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF WESTON, TEXAS, DECLARING A LACK OF CONFIDENCE IN THE CITY SECRETARY; REMOVING THE CITY SECRETARY FROM OFFICE PURSUANT TO TEXAS LOCAL GOVERNMENT CODE SECTION 22.077(B); AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Town of Weston, Texas (the "Town"), is a general law municipality located in Collin County, created in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 6 of the Local Government Code and operating pursuant to the enabling legislation of the State of Texas; and

WHEREAS, the City Secretary is a municipal officer appointed by the governing body of the Town of Weston, Texas; and

WHEREAS, Section 22.077(b) of the Texas Local Government Code provides that if the governing body lacks confidence in a municipal officer appointed by the governing body, the governing body may remove the officer at any time; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the Town of Weston ("Town Council") has determined that it lacks confidence in Suzanne Scott DiNicola as the City Secretary; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council finds that it is in the best interest of the Town to remove the City Secretary as authorized by state law.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF WESTON, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. The recitals contained in the preamble of this Resolution are determined to be true and correct and are hereby adopted as a part of this Resolution.

SECTION 2. The findings set forth above are incorporated into the body of this Resolution as if fully set forth herein.

SECTION 3. The Town Council hereby declares a lack of confidence in Suzanne Scott DiNicola in her capacity as City Secretary for the Town of Weston, Texas.

SECTION 4. Pursuant to Texas Local Government Code Section 22.077(b), Suzanne Scott DiNicola is hereby removed from the office of City Secretary, effective immediately.

SECTION 5. This Resolution is adopted with at least two-thirds of the elected aldermen voting in favor of its passage, as required by Section 22.077(b) of the Texas Local Government Code.

SECTION 6. If any section, article, or provision of this Resolution is held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity shall not affect the remaining portions of this Resolution.

SECTION 7. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage and

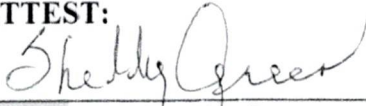

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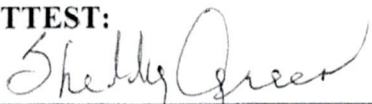
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
