A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF WESTON, TEXAS, ADOPTING AN UPDATED MUNICIPAL SERVICE PLAN; ESTABLISHING THAT THIS SERVICE PLAN SUPERSEDES ANY PRIOR INFORMAL OR ADMINISTRATIVE VERSIONS; PROVIDING FOR PERIODIC REVIEW; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Town of Weston, Texas ("Town") is required under Chapter 43 of the Texas Local Government Code to maintain a Municipal Service Plan applicable to areas annexed into the Town; and

WHEREAS, the Town has historically maintained a Service Plan document for public reference, but no ordinance or resolution formally adopting such plan has been located in the Town's legislative archives; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council finds it necessary and in the best interest of the Town to formally adopt an updated Municipal Service Plan to ensure clarity, transparency, and compliance with state law;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF WESTON, TEXAS, THAT:

**SECTION 1
ADOPTION OF SERVICE PLAN**

The City Council hereby adopts the "Town of Weston Texas Municipal Service Plan," attached hereto as Exhibit A, as the official Service Plan of the Town.

**SECTION 2
SUPERSESSION**

This Resolution supersedes and replaces any prior Service Plan documents, drafts, or administrative versions previously posted or referenced.

**SECTION 3
PERIODIC REVIEW**

The Service Plan shall be reviewed at least once every five (5) years, or more frequently as needed, and may be amended by Resolution of the Town Council.

**SECTION 4
EFFECTIVE**

This Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after March 24, 2026 and it is so resolved.

EXHIBIT A

Town of Weston Service Plan

A. POLICE PROTECTION

The Town of Weston, Texas does not provide police protection within the Town. Police protection is available through the Collin County Sheriff's Dept.

B. FIRE PROTECTION AND AMBULANCE SERVICE

The Town of Weston, Texas provides fire protection via the Weston Fire Department and Mutual Aid from the fire departments in Anna, Celina, Melissa, and McKinney. The Town of Weston provides fire-based EMS to the Town of Weston, its Extraterritorial Jurisdiction ("ETJ"), and its Ultimate Mutual Boundary ("UMB"), through a contracted partnership with Allegiance Mobile Health to respond to 9-1-1 calls.

C. SOLID WASTE COLLECTION

The Town of Weston does not provide waste collection. A list of area providers may be found at www.westontexas.com on the "For Residents" tab.

D. MAINTENANCE OF WATER AND WASTE WATER FACILITIES

The Town owns and maintains one wastewater facility. Depending on your location, water service is available through either Weston Water Supply Corporation, North Collin Special Utility District or Mustang Special Utility District. Contact information for these providers can be found at www.westontexas.com on the "For Residents" tab.

E. MAINTENANCE OF ROADS AND STREETS

Any and all public roads and streets which have been dedicated to the Town of Weston, Texas, or which are owned by the Town of Weston, Texas, shall be maintained to the same degree and extent that other roads and streets are maintained in areas with similar topography, land use and population density. The Town of Weston provides lighting of public roads and streets. Said roads and streets which may be positioned in a right-of-way, roadway or utility company easement are maintained by the applicable utility company servicing the Town of Weston, Texas, pursuant to the rules, regulations and fees of such utility.

F. MAINTENANCE OF PARKS, PLAYGROUNDS AND SWIMMING POOLS

The Town Council of the Town of Weston, Texas, is not aware of the existence of any parks, playgrounds or swimming pools now located in the area proposed for annexation. In the event any such parks, playgrounds or swimming pools do exist and are public facilities, the Town of Weston, Texas, will maintain such areas to the same extent and degree that it maintains parks, playgrounds and swimming pools and other similar areas of the Town now incorporated in the Town of Weston, Texas.

G. MAINTENANCE OF MUNICIPALLY OWNED FACILITY, BUILDING OR MUNICIPAL SERVICE

The Town Council of the Town of Weston, Texas, is not aware of the existence of any municipally owned facility, building or other municipal service now located in the area proposed for annexation. In the event any such municipally owned facility, building or municipal service does exist and are public facilities, the Town of Weston, Texas, will maintain such areas to the same extent and degree that it maintains publicly owned facilities, buildings or municipal services of the Town now incorporated in the Town of Weston, Texas. The Town of Weston currently maintains the Weston Community Center.

H. ANIMAL CONTROL

All residents within the city limits will be provided animal control and sheltering services through an agreement with Collin County.

I. POLICE PROTECTION

The Town Council of the Town of Weston, Texas finds and determines it to be unnecessary to acquire or construct any capital improvement for the purposes of providing police protection since the Town of Weston does not provide police services directly.

J. WATER FACILITIES

The Town Council of the City of Weston, Texas, has determined that water is available for point of service extension from the appropriate third-party provider in accordance with the Town's utility polices and ordinances. Therefore, Capital Improvements are not necessary to provide full municipal services for water.

K. WASTEWATER FACILITIES

The Town Council of the ^{Town}City of Weston, Texas, has determined that wastewater service is only available for one area of the Town via a development agreement, including the newly annexed area. As a result, Capital Improvements are not currently necessary to provide equivalent full municipal services for wastewater.

L. ROADS AND STREETS

Within 2 1/2 years, the Town of Weston, Texas, with a cooperative effort of the Town's designated utility company, will undertake to provide the same degree of road and street lighting as is provided in areas of similar topography, land use and population density within the present corporate limits of the Town of Weston, Texas. Maintenance of properly dedicated roads and streets will be consistent with the maintenance provided by the Town to other roads and streets in areas of similar topography, land use and sub-development of the annexed property. Developers will be required pursuant to the ordinances of the Town of Weston, Texas, to provide internal and peripheral streets and to construct those streets in accordance with the specifications required by the Town of Weston, Texas, for the properly dedicated street. Town participation in capital expenditures will be in accordance with Town policies.

M. CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS

Notwithstanding any other provision of this service plan, a landowner within the newly annexed area will not be required to fund capital improvements necessary to provide municipal services in a manner inconsistent with Chapter 395 of the Local Government Code, unless otherwise agreed to by the landowner.

SPECIFIC FINDINGS

The Town Council of the Town of Weston, Texas finds and determines that this proposed Service Plan will not provide any fewer services, and it will not provide a lower level of service in the area proposed to be annexed than were in existence in the proposed area at the time immediately preceding the annexation process.

Because of the differing characteristics of topography, land utilization and population density, the service levels which may ultimately be provided in the newly annexed area may differ somewhat from services provided other areas of the Town of Weston, Texas. These differences are specifically dictated because of differing characteristics of the property and the Town of Weston, Texas will undertake to perform consistent with this contract so as to provide the newly annexed area with the same type, kind and quality of service presently enjoyed by the citizens of the Town of Weston, Texas who reside in areas of similar topography, land utilization and population.
